



We'll explore Section 1 of this book and seek answers to foundational questions such as: In what sense is the Bible God's Word, and in what sense is it human reflections on God? What do we mean by calling it "inspired"? Is it inerrant or infallible? How was the Bible written? What different types of writings are found in the Bible? How did different writings make it into the Bible?

Ruth Circle meets at 6:30 p.m. the second Tuesday evening of each month. They also invite all women who would like to join.




Prayer Team meets Monday mornings at 10:00 a.m. Anyone interested is invited to come pray with us!
