June Sermon Series: Dysfunctional Families in the Bible

We begin the month commemorating Trinity Sunday. It is a good transition from the celebration of Easter to the season of Pentecost. In fact, our Scripture reading is the final words in the Gospel of Matthew where Jesus sends his disciples out to bring others into this fellowship.

I often choose my sermon texts from a series of prescribed readings known as the lectionary. This is used by a number of denominations and is optional for United Methodists. I noticed that several texts in the upcoming weeks relate stories of families in the book of Genesis. But these are not sanitized versions. They often read more like soap operas showing that God can and does work through less than perfect people to do amazing things in the world. We will look at these original dysfunctional families in June and July in the hope of strengthening our families and our communities.

Welcoming Project Transformation to New Hope!

Project Transformation is a summer literacy day camp for elementary children living in low-income households who are behind in their reading. This is the 22nd Summer for Project Transformation in Oklahoma, a ministry of our Oklahoma United Methodist Conference. And, for the first time, New Hope will be a host site! United Methodist churches in Tulsa, Muskogee, El Reno, and Enid will also be hosting Project Transformation camps this year!

In addition to reading, campers experience many fun activities including art, recreation, crafts, STEM, and field trips!

Twenty-nine children from Ralph Downs Elementary will take part in Project Transformation at New Hope! The day-to-day operations of the camp will be handled by four college students employed by Project Transformation. Here are the days and times of camp:

Monday-Thursday, 9 AM – 3 PM June 5 – July 27 (no camp June 19 and July 3 & 4)

Your help is both appreciated and needed to help ensure a great experience for our campers. Here are some ways you can be involved. Sign up information will be coming soon!

Tutor Children. We seek 12-15 tutors Monday-Thursday from 10-noon to read one-on-one with campers. Sign up for the dates that fit your schedule. Come one time or many times!

Provide Snacks. Provide an afternoon snack for our campers. Choose one or more days to provide the snack. (You can deliver your snack ahead of time.)

Provide Monday Dinner. Each Monday evening, New Hope will feed the four college interns serving at our site. You can bring a meal, take them out to dinner, invite them to your home or offer a gift card for them to eat a meal out. Choose one or more days. This is a great opportunity for Sunday School classes and other groups to extend hospitality and get to know our college interns!

Serve Lunch Meal. – help heat and serve the lunch meal. Food for campers will come on trays from the Oklahoma Regional Food Bank. Time: Monday-Thursday from 11:30 AM -12:30 PM. Choose one or more days!

Help with Family Fun Nights. During the Summer, New Hope will host two fun nights for campers and their families. More details to come!

As 2023 dawns, we invite you to explore the many ministry and mission opportunities at New Hope! Meet new friends, learn new things, serve God and community in new ways! Here are a few opportunities you want to check out:

Men of Hope: meet the 3rd Sunday of each month at New Hope for breakfast. The Men of Hope undertake various service projects and philanthropic endeavors.

Young at Heart: meets on the 4th Thursday of each month. This fellowship group often travels to locations of interest in the OKC metro and sometimes around the state. Young at Heart gatherings always include great fellowship and good food!

Women's Circles: The Mary/Martha Circle meets the 2nd Thursday at 9:30AM. The Women of Faith (formerly known as United Methodist Women) meets the 3rd Thursday at 6:30 PM. The Ruth Circle meets the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM.

2nd Saturday Homeless Outreach: New Hope children for or comes alongside neighbors who are currently homeless with friendship, encouragement, food, clothing, bedding, and toiletry items. The 2nd Saturday of each month from 9:30 AM-Noon, volunteers from New Hope travel downtown and across OKC to support our homeless neighbors.

Food Pantry and Blessing Box: The New Hope Food Pantry and Blessing Box provides shelf-stable food to our neighbors experiencing food insecurity. The Blessings Box is available at all times and the food pantry is open the 2nd and 4th Tuesday each month from 1-3 PM.

Stitchers Sewing Group: Blankets, pillowcases, and more are created by the Stitchers and given to patrons of social services agencies such as The Infant Crisis Center and the YWCA. All skill levels are welcome! The Stitchers sewing group meets on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month from 11 AM - 3 PM.

Whiz Kids: Each Monday afternoon from 3-5 PM during the school year at New Hope, Whiz Kids brings together caring adults and elementary-age children for one-on-one tutoring and mentoring. New Hope partners with Ralph Downs Elementary. Whiz Kids at New Hope currently needs substitute tutors!
