The season of Lent is a time of self-reflection, repentance, and attending more closely to our walk with God. It's deep purple color and somber hymns make the presence of death a looming reality. But it is also a time of hope. We go through the darkness in anticipation of light ahead. While we wait for the new day to dawn, we find that the night has its own wonders and moments of grace. The sermons during Lent will follow the readings in the lectionary from the gospels. We begin and end with Matthew – Jesus tempted in the wilderness and his triumphal entry into Jerusalem. In between we check in with John's telling of a series of encounters Jesus has with people in times of transition.
